

# Human risk as a compliance driver

**Why it matters:** Organisations are increasingly expected to evidence staff awareness and policy acknowledgement, not rely on annual check-box training.

**Expectations:** Regional privacy laws such as **LGPD (Brazil), Argentina Law 25.326, Chile Law 19.628/21.719, Colombia Law 1581, and Peru Law 29733** increasingly expect documented controls and audit-ready records.

**Where organisations struggle:** Annual training, inconsistent evidence, no policy acceptance trail, limited visibility.
