

# Human risk as a compliance driver

Human behaviour plays a significant role in meeting APAC privacy and security expectations. Organisations are increasingly expected to show awareness, policy acknowledgement, and behavioural oversight.

## What's driving requirements

Regional frameworks increasingly expect continuous awareness and auditable evidence:

- **China CSL + India DPDP:** governance, documented handling practices, and records that support compliance
- **Japan APPI + Singapore requirements:** policy acknowledgement and audit evidence of risk management
- **SEA privacy laws (PDPA/PDP):** consistent evidence over personal data handling across teams and locations



### Where organisations struggle

- Limited IT time to manage ongoing training, policy sign-off, and reporting alongside day-to-day operations
- Outdated annual training that doesn't stand up to audits or customer reviews
- Policy acceptance scattered across inboxes and folders, making proof hard to produce on demand
