



Human risk as a compliance driver

Data breaches are costly across Europe, **averaging €3.46M in Germany** (\$4.03M) and **€5.36M in the Benelux region** (\$6.24M). With the human element involved in around 60% of breaches, regulators, insurers, and customers increasingly expect **auditable evidence that people-related controls are working**, not just that policies exist.

What's driving requirements

European regulators, customers, and supply chain partners increasingly expect continuous, auditable evidence:

- **GDPR + ISO 27001:** appropriate measures supported by awareness, policies, and evidence they are understood and followed
- **NIS2:** risk-management measures and stronger management accountability, including workforce practices and supply chain security
- **DORA (financial services):** higher expectations for ICT risk management and operational resilience, including governance and third-party oversight evidence



Where organisations struggle

- Limited IT time to manage ongoing training, policy sign-off, and reporting alongside day-to-day operations
- Outdated annual training that doesn't stand up to audits or customer reviews
- Policy acceptance scattered across inboxes and folders, making proof hard to produce on demand
- Evidence spread across tools, creating manual work and slowing audits and assurance requests
