

# Human risk as a compliance driver

Human behaviour is increasingly important in meeting Latin America's privacy and security expectations. Organisations are expected to evidence staff awareness, policy acknowledgement, and responsible data handling.

## What's driving requirements

Regional privacy laws increasingly emphasise documented controls and audit-ready records:

- **Brazil (LGPD):** accountability measures supported by policies, awareness, and demonstrable controls
- **Argentina (Law 25.326):** responsible data handling and organisational safeguards
- **Chile (Law 19.628; Law 21.719 effective Dec 2026):** rising expectations for governance and control evidence
- **Colombia (Law 1581) + Peru (Law 29733):** documented controls and clear accountability for how personal data is handled



### Where organisations struggle

- Limited IT time to manage ongoing training, policy sign-off, and reporting alongside day-to-day operations
- Outdated annual training that doesn't stand up to audits or customer reviews
- Policy acceptance scattered across inboxes and folders, making proof hard to produce on demand
- Evidence spread across tools, creating manual work and slowing audits and assurance requests
